It does not matter which brand you use or the color ‘name’ on the tube as long as the color **has the proper Color Bias**. Tube names of 3 popular brands are listed. You can mix and match brands.

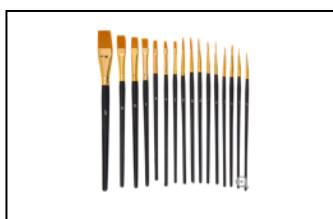
Other Supplies to Purchase

Shared Items. You can purchase your own but we usually share these 3 items: 1) ‘Silicoil Brush Cleaning Tank’ filled with odorless turpentine, 2) Gamblin Galkyd or Galkyd Lite to thin and dry paint (Don’t use Liquin or other turpentine based thinners in class), 3) Gamblin Gamsol. Mixed 50/50 with Galkyd to oil out.



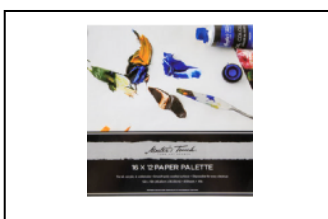
Canvas

16” x 20” or 11” x 14” stretched canvas or canvas panel. Often on sale & also sold in packs.



Brush Set

A packaged set of soft, “taklon” brushes that contain flat and pointed brushes.



Palette Pad

Each sheet is designed for oil or acrylic & they're disposable to offer a quick and easy cleanup.



Other

Paper towels are a must for clean up. A metal or plastic palette knife is also very handy.
